

Personal data processing disclaimer

2. The Theatre has appointed a Data Protection Officer whom you can contact by:

3. The personal data you provided in the application will be processed in order to carry out the audition (recruitment) process for the position of tutti viola (full time) in the TWON Orchestra based on the necessity for compliance with a legal obligation to which the controller is subject in accordance with the Polish Labour Code and based on your consent (additional data beyond the scope of Article 22(1) of the Labour Code, including contact information), which can be withdrawn at any time. By submitting an application containing personal data beyond the scope of Article 22(1) of the Labour Code, you consent to the processing of that data by TWON for the purposes of this recruitment process.
4. The personal data you provided in the application will be stored throughout the recruitment process. If you consent to the processing of your personal data for future recruitment purposes, the data will be stored for one year.
5. The recipients of your personal data will be providers of cloud services, including e-mail services.
6. You have the right to:
 - access your personal data and obtain a copy of them,
 - rectify your personal data,
 - restrict the processing of your personal data,
 - have the data erased,
 - and lodge a complaint with the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection in Warsaw (Urząd Ochrony Danych Osobowych, ul. Stawki 2, 00-193 Warszawa).
7. You may also withdraw your consent at any time, which does not impede the lawfulness of the processing of your personal data before the consent was withdrawn.
8. Providing the personal data required by Article 22(1) of the Labour Code is voluntary, yet it is a requisite for participating in the recruitment process.
