

The Opera Gallery COVID-19 Safety Requirements

I. General Safety Rules

1. The following safety measures must be taken by the staff, contractors and visitors of the Opera Gallery.
2. The Gallery is open Wednesday–Sunday, 11 a.m.–6 p.m.
3. Visitors are admitted to the Gallery through entry no. A-036.
4. Prior to entering the Gallery, a Visitor must buy an entry ticket at the Box Office situated in the main lobby of the opera house. We would appreciate it if you could pay by card.
5. The staff and contractors of the Gallery are obligated to:
 - a) Pay attention to the health condition of the persons present at the Gallery and take appropriate steps whenever necessary, while making sure to protect their own health. In particular, they are obligated to immediately inform their supervisor if they notice signs or symptoms of infectious disease in themselves, other member of the staff, a contractor or visitor.
 - b) Disinfect their hands using the hand sanitiser provided each time they enter the Gallery.
 - c) Practice social distancing (that is keep space of at least 1.5 meters between themselves and other persons) whenever possible taking into account the nature of their job, or use personal protective equipment (PPE) as described below.
 - d) The security guards, box office staff and visitor services staff are required to wear face shields/masks covering their mouth and nose as well as single-use gloves. The PPE should be replaced in line with the manufacturer's instructions.
 - e) Dispose of used PPE into the lidded bin provided for that purpose.
 - f) Follow other instructions issued by their supervisors and persons authorised to work to prevent the spread of the SARS-CoV-2 virus.
6. All visitors are obligated to:
 - a) Wear face masks covering their mouth and nose when inside the Gallery.
 - b) Disinfect their hands using the hand sanitiser provided each time they enter the Gallery.
 - c) Practice social distancing (that is keep space of at least 1.5 meters between themselves and other persons).
 - d) Dispose of used PPE into the lidded bin provided for that purpose.

II. Safety in the Gallery Opera spaces

1. No more than 20 persons can be present inside the Opera Gallery at any given time, including 5 persons in Room 1, 10 persons in Room 2, 6 persons in Room 3, and 6 persons in the space surrounding the staircase.
2. The number of people present inside the Gallery is monitored by a security guard at the entrance, who hands out numbered tokens to every new visitor. Visitors are

required to return the tokens when leaving the Gallery. The tokens are disinfected after each use.

3. Security guards will ensure that visitors follow these safety requirements on a continuous basis.
4. The cloakrooms are out of use.
5. These safety requirements will be displayed at the entrance to the Gallery.
6. A person displaying signs or symptoms of infectious disease may be denied entry to the Gallery or asked to leave the Gallery if such signs or symptoms become apparent in the course of their visit.
